FIJI - 300 islands are waiting to greet you

- **Lautoka** - Even though the close-knit community of Lautoka has only 42,000 inhabitants, it is the second largest city in Fiji. With numerous natural treasures and unique habitats, it is quite simply a magnificent haven. The name of this beautiful town translates as 'spear hit', arising from a duel between two chiefs.

FRENCH POLYNESIA - Is this the most beautiful place in the world?

- **Bora Bora** - "The Pearl of the Pacific", as Captain Cook baptised her, bears the magic of the most beautiful Polynesian islands. This ancient stretched volcano shows two peaks, Mounts Pahia and Otemanu, whose green colours stand out against the jade, turquoise and sapphire shades of the lagoon.

- **Raiatea** - Raiatea is recognised throughout French Polynesia as a "Sacred Island"- the cultural heart of all French Polynesia. The island holds much fascinating history, legend, and lore, as well as French Polynesia's most significant archeological sites.

- **Moorea** - To the visitor, Moorea appears as a tropical garden filled with silver pineapple fields. In the midst of this fairy tale landscape, light rays penetrate the Mou'a Puta ("the pierced mountain"). Was it formed by natural eccentricity, or according to the legend, the arrow of the demigod Pai? All of this, along with Afareaitu's waterfalls and the famous Captain Cook and Opunohu Bays make this a magical place to visit.

HAWAII - A mosaic of food, festivals and fragrances

- **Honolulu, Oahu** - Hawaii's capital city, Honolulu is an exciting mix of past and present— with sleek, modern architecture and stately Victorian-era buildings. Out of the city, make for Diamond Head Crater, the most recognisable of Hawaii's natural symbols, where a hike to the top of the crater will reward you with an incomparable view of Honolulu and the famous Waikiki Beach. Pay a visit to the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbour, or discover the spectacular scenery and fascinating marine life of Little Circle Island.
