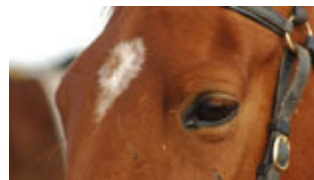

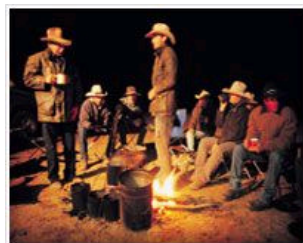
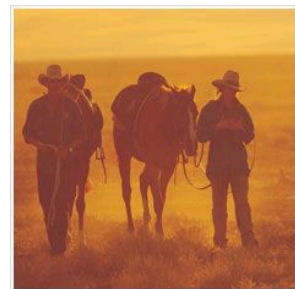

"SADDLE UP FOR THE JOURNEY"

A unique opportunity to take part in an original historic cattle drive when you saddle up for the journey in 2010. This epic experience involves 500 head of cattle and 150 horses, along with visitors from across Australia and around the world. A swag of adventure stories along one of the most evocative stock trails – South Australia's Oodnadatta Track. You'll ride with some of Australia's finest drovers and relive a very real part of Australian history, driving cattle on horseback through the Outback.

TOUR 1

DAWN OF THE CATTLE DRIVE 30 JULY - 3 AUGUST

You'll be a part of the 'handover and counting of cattle', the official start of the Drive. The scenery is spectacular with sandy dunes & wide flat corridors covered with native plants.

TOUR 2

DROVERS CROSSING 4 - 8 AUGUST

Watch as the scenery changes from gravelly clays with scattered river red gum to undulating stony tableland. It then changes from deep red to yellow sand dunes with sandy clay swales.

TOUR 3

KIDMAN COUNTRY 9 - 13 AUGUST

You will follow the remains of the original Ghan railway track line. You'll hear the stories of the settlers, their successes and failures along with historical accounts by descendants of the original inhabitants.



TOUR 4

CATTLE KINGS 15 - 19 AUGUST

The scenery is spectacular with sandy dunes & wide flat corridors covered with native plants. Hear stories of the settlers, their successes and failures along with historical accounts by descendants from original inhabitants.

TOUR 5

RINGERS RUN 20 - 24 AUGUST

Located on Anna Creek Station, you have the rare opportunity to enter the world's largest cattle station, measuring some 26,000 square kilometres (5.5 million acres), which is roughly the size of Belgium.

TOUR 6

CATTLE DRIVE ROUND UP 25 - 29 AUGUST

Departing from William Creek you will have an opportunity to explore the world's largest cattle station, Anna Creek. As you travel keep your eyes out for historic farm relics left by the drovers of the past.

All prices are per person in New Zealand dollars, exclude the international airfare to Adelaide from New Zealand and are subject to availability at the time of booking. **An additional payment of \$1625 is required for single supplement.** A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is required on confirmation of booking. Full non-refundable balance of payment will be required by 01 March 2010. Please book best available published airfare from New Zealand to Adelaide.
